

Copenhagen's first hydrogen energy photovoltaic sites

What is the hydrogen power project in Copenhagen?

The hydrogen power project in Copenhagen is a large-scale facility powered by offshore wind. When fully scaled up by 2030, it is expected to deliver more than 250,000 tonnes of fuel to the industry and reduce annual carbon emissions by up to 850,000 tonnes.

How can Energinet help Denmark's future hydrogen infrastructure?

Energinet plays a central role in shaping Denmark's future hydrogen infrastructure. A key project is the Danish Hydrogen Backbone- a new pipeline system in Jutland designed to support the green transition, link Danish hydrogen production with the German market, and contribute to the development of a wider European hydrogen infrastructure.

How can Denmark produce green electricity?

Denmark is uniquely positioned to produce large amounts of green electricity from wind and solar power. This renewable energy can be transformed into green hydrogen through Power-to-X - a key technology that enables energy storage and use in sectors where direct electrification is not an option.

What is Denmark's hydrogen infrastructure?

The Danish hydrogen infrastructure is rooted in political agreements and carried out in close collaboration with hydrogen market players. Energinet is preparing Denmark's future hydrogen infrastructure - and it begins in Southern Jutland. A new pipeline is being prepared from Esbjerg to Veerst near Egtved.
