How will WFP support El Salvador in 2022?

Emergency preparedness and response, disaster risk management, anticipatory action and community-based adaptation will strengthen adaptive capacity to face new slow- and rapid-onset shocks. This country strategic plan articulates WFP's proposed support for El Salvador from 2022 to 2027.

Why is El Salvador facing a humanitarian crisis?

Salvadoran Civil Protection El Salvador is grappling with a humanitarian crisis characterized by compounding threats of extreme weather events, human mobility, and persistent food insecurity, worsened by global economic pressures and rising inflation.

How much money does El Salvador need in 2025?

In 2025, the humanitarian community aims to assist 407,500 of El Salvador's most vulnerable people—about 49 per cent of those in need—requiring \$66.9 million. The number of people in need has decreased slightly from 2024 due to a prioritized analysis of municipalities and milder-than-expected impacts from the El Niño-induced drought.

Is El Salvador a source or transit point?

El Salvador serves as both a source and transit point for people on the move. From October 2022 to September 2023, authorities intercepted more than 62,800 Salvadorans at the United States' southern border. In 2022, there were 14,437 returnees, marking a 70 per cent increase from 2021.
