Gaborone averages 3,200 hours of sunlight annually, making it an ideal location for solar power generation. Solar PV panels convert this abundant sunlight into electricity, reducing reliance on ...

Botswana does have an impressive solar resource, but its exploitation requires a great number of tradeoffs. As a result, there are a limited number of larger-scale solar systems in the country.

The city experiences an impressive average daily generation of 6.61 kWh per kW of installed solar in summer, 6.03 kWh in autumn, 5.05 kWh in winter and a remarkable 7.46 kWh during spring.
