



# How much does a solar photovoltaic panel cost per watt

How much do solar panels cost?

As of 2026, the average cost of residential solar panels in the U.S. is between \$15,000 and \$25,000 before incentives. This typically translates to about \$2.50 to \$3.50 per watt of installed capacity (more on price per watt below). The total price depends on your system size, location, roof type, and installer.

How much does solar cost per watt?

The price per watt for larger and relatively straightforward projects are often within the \$2.50 to \$3 range. Claiming incentives like tax credits and rebates can bring the PPW even lower. However, the following factors may push your solar price per watt into the \$3 to \$4.50 range.

How much does a home solar system cost?

According to studies by the U.S. Department of Energy, the all-in cost of a home solar panel system is between \$2.74 to \$3.30 per watt. <sup>1,2,12</sup> This figure includes the solar panels, the installation, and other expenses. Using these numbers, an average-sized 8-kilowatt residential solar system would cost between \$21,900 - \$26,400.

How much does a 12 kW solar panel cost?

Your state's averages matter more than national numbers, and factors like shading, roof complexity, and local incentive programs all play a role in your final price. The average cost of a 12 kW solar panel installation on EnergySage is \$30,505 before available incentives.

How Much Do Solar Panels Cost in 2026? The average homeowner spends \$19,873 on solar panels, but costs range from \$12,600 to \$33,376 depending on system size and location

The cost per watt of solar panels is the price of generating 1 watt of electricity using solar panels: \$3-\$5 per watt for residential and \$2-\$4 for commercial.
