

North Korea Power Base Station Project

North Korean leader Kim Jong-un praised the completion of a small hydropower station in Hoeyang County, Kangwon Province, calling the achievement "a precious success" as he continues to ...

While North Korea began moving away from large-scale hydropower projects with massive dams around a decade ago, one such project had been under construction for so long, it only opened in August 2022.

The project crosses 45 km of the Orang River and stretches through 40 km of water tunnels, past 4 dams and 5 power stations. The country estimates that the project will produce 134,500 kW in energy.
