According to IEA, in 2015, Norway exports about 15% of its electricity generation and imports about 5%, and the net electricity export was 14.645 TWh. In 2021, exports were 24.7 TWh and imports 7.6 TWh, mostly from Sweden. Norway and Sweden's grids have long been connected across the 1630 km long border. The North Sea Link HVDC Norway to Great Britain cable was opened in October 2021, while the Scotland-Norway interconnector NorthConnect is on hold due to Norwegian policy.
