

Port-au-prince power outages

A widespread power outage has affected the Port-au-Prince area and Haiti's Centre department since Tuesday, after protesters forced the shutdown of the Peligre hydroelectric plant.

The closure of the Peligre dam has plunged Port-au-Prince and several regions into darkness, intensifying fears of a nationwide energy collapse amid a looming fuel shortage.
